

I have researched every signer of our founding documents, have written a biographical section on each of them from a religious perspective, and have appended a series of quotations relating to that signer's views on religion and its place in American society. My premise is that we as a country have strayed far from what our Founding Fathers intended, and that the fundamental, underlying reason for that is that we have lost God. 


