The first session is on **building trust and eliminating suspicion**. This session explains how and why suspicion creeps into our team dynamic and how to make “trust” an intentional priority for your team.

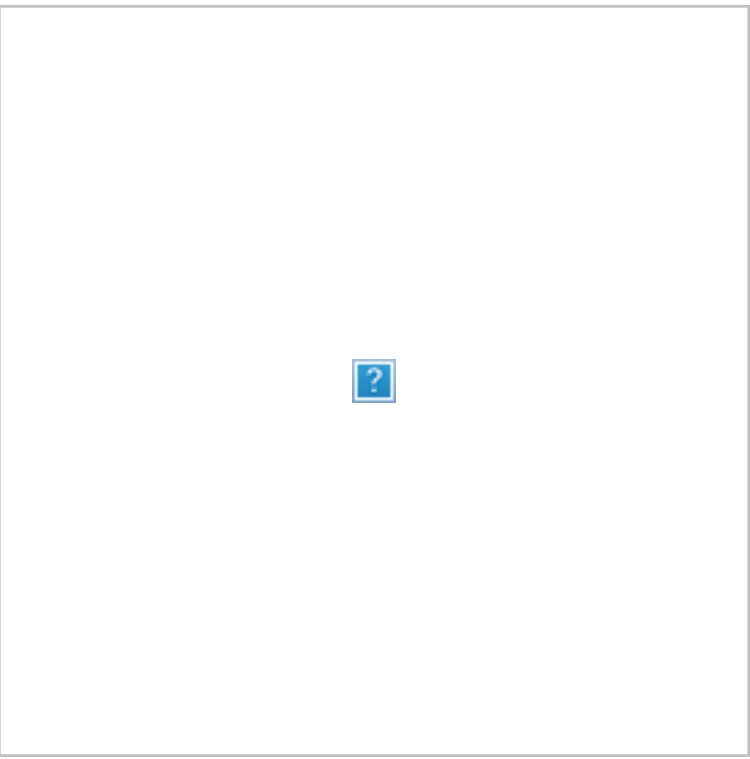
