The National Landscape of Long-term Shelters - Staff Training

The National Practices Survey Report 2017 surveyed the staff training practices of approximately 60 agencies around the US. 57% of these agencies reported requiring quarterly formal training for staff, and 25% reported monthly training. Some of the statistics from this report include:

Staff training resources used by residential agencies:

Human Trafficking:

81% Recommend certain books

79% Recommend certain videos

55% Recommend classes

69% Encourage/require them to attend the agency's public awareness programs

Trauma and Trauma-Informed Care:

5% Certain staff are certified in trauma-informed care

86% All staff have received some level of training in trauma

5% Only staff who work with survivors have received training in trauma

5% Have not provided specific training in trauma to staff

Agency Policies and Protocols:

79% Offer specific training to staff in the agency's approach to care, philosophy, and practices 86% Have a staff handbook/training manual, outlining the agency's approach to care, rules, and protocols

43% Do most of their training as on-the-job training

57% Documentation Protocols

55% Substance Abuse 52% CPR

52% Emergency Medical procedures

52% Mental disorders

52% Shame

50% Self-harming behaviors 48% Emergency evacuation

36% Motivational interviewing
