Prison Fellowship: A Resource for Prison Culture and How To Support Clients with Reentry

Many of the clients you work with have spent time in prison. One resource that can help with learning about the specific culture of life in prison is **Prison Fellowship**.

For example, Prison Fellowship explains that:

"Sometimes borrowing something from another prisoner can become an issue. If the debt is not repaid quickly, it is considered disrespectful and can lead to violence. This is a part of prison culture that doesn't always make sense. However, the reality is that most prisoners believe respect must be maintained at all costs."


