This month we will be discussing ad-hoc support for survivors, including resources for family, peers and communities.

- **Life After 'The Life': Putting Families Back Together After Children are Trafficked** (Sara Tiano, 2018) This article describes a parenting skills group for families of trafficking survivors. It also explains secondary traumatic stress (STS) and how families can be affected by the process of supporting survivors.
- **Adapting Peer Support Models for Survivors at the Intersection of Trafficking and Substance Use** (Department of HHS, Administration for Children and Families, Office on Trafficking in Persons, 2019) An in-depth review of the effectiveness of peer support and survivor recovery.
- **Peer Support Groups for Individuals Who Have Experienced Human Trafficking and Substance Use Disorder Exploratory Brief** (National Human Trafficking Training and Technical Assistance Center) This resource includes the principles of various peer support models and survivor feedback.
- **Empowerment and Employment of Survivors of Human Trafficking: A Business Guide** (Business for Social Responsibility, 2020) This guide provides businesses with an understanding of the assisting survivors in long-term recovery.
- **20 Ways You Can Help Fight Human Trafficking** (Department of State) This is an extensive list of ways for communities to be involved in fighting trafficking, ranging from prevention to aiding survivor recovery and everything in between.

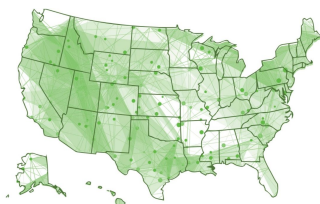
