Home Environment

- Use your walls
- Spread out the books
- Get a green thumb
- Embrace pets
- Designate spaces for variety & mobility
- Reduce/hide the clutter
- Consider environment sensitivities
- Fill with happy things and family memorabilia



Character Training

- Set the example
- Point out behavior
- Character issues are teaching tools
- Relate in conflict
- Book/movie character discussions
- Biblical standard
- Pray for discernment
- "In the way they should go..."
- Loan out your faith
- Volunteer & serve together



Lifestyle of Learning

- Don't overschedule
- Teach beyond books
- Ask questions
- Live in awe & wonder
- Create safe spaces to explore
- Be okay with mistakes
- Set the example and keep learning new things yourself
- Experiment
- Embrace free play & trying new thing
