

MEDICAL AMBASSADORS INTERNATIONAL

At Medical Ambassadors International (MAI) we believe development work should be communityowned. We promote this core principle by training workers in a very specific development philosophy known as Community Health Evangelism (CHE), which focuses on transforming lives both physically and spiritually.

VISION SEMINAR

If you are not sure what CHE is, but are interested in learning more, the Vision Seminar is where you start. If you are unsure CHE is a good fit for your or your missions program, this is the training for you.

A two-day Vision Seminar allows you to learn the basics and decide what your next step should be. You will learn:

- CHE Concepts Understanding the Need
- Defining Good Health
- Worldview and Development
- Comparing Relief, Betterment and Development
- LePSAS (the CHE learning model)
- Needs and Resources
- ...and much more



TRAINING OF TRAINERS 1 (TOT-1)

A TOT-1 is approximately 25-32 hours of training covering in detail the principles of CHE. The training teaches about in-country field structures and how to take the first steps in starting a CHE program. TOT-1 is intended to instruct missionaries or individuals before they start their service. It is not necessary to attend a Vision Seminar first.

Various topics may include:

- Community Ownership
- Sustainability
- CHE Concepts—Understanding the Need
- The Great Commission and the Great
 Commandment
- God's Vision for Community
- Worldview and Development
- CHE Description—Basic Elements of a CHE Ministry
- Roles and Responsibilities in a CHE Program
- Information Gathering
- Seed Projects
- Steps to Start a CHE Program
- ...plus other elective topics.
- A TOT-1 is typically taught in five consecutive days, but we can also make other arrangements.

INTERNSHIPS

Typically 5 weeks (varies per location) with a combination of classroom learning and hands-on experience in CHE programs. Prerequisite: TOT-1 (Some parts of the world require TOT-2 and -3 as well.)



TRAINING OF TRAINERS FOR SHORT-TERM MISSIONS (TOT-s)

TOT-s training is for churches and organizations that send out short-term teams. It includes the principle of CHE, but it doesn't concentrate on how to run a program. Instead, the training covers:

- CHE Options for Short-Term Teams
- How to Do Missions Without Causing Harm
- Understanding Relief and Development
- Understanding Predominant Worldviews and How They Affect Cultures and Faith
- Equipping Teams to Understand Cultural Areas of Conflict That Can Create Problems
- Delivering Practical Training
- LePSAS Learning Techniques and Practices
- Bible Storying
- Transitioning From Relief to Developmentbased Missions
- ...plus other topics

If you want your short-term team to benefit current CHE programs, this is the training for your group. Also, if you have sent teams in the past to the same location but with little results, we encourage you to consider this training.
