
Honor Shame Dynamics: How to serve effectively

Understand misunderstandings when reaching out with compassion in honor shame cultures.

When we show Christ's love, people interpret what we do based on their worldview. In Honor-Shame cultures, people might misinterpret and see in our actions merit making, proselytization or apostasy, however pure our motivation may be. We will look at honor-shame based worldviews, come to understand how and why people may misinterpret what we do and look at risks and practices that may help us show and share God's love appropriately. To illustrate, the workshop will use observations from relief and urban poor work in SE Asia. Application is relevant both overseas or close to home when reaching out to neighbors from honor-shame contexts.







Shame = about who you feel you are (or what others ascribe)


Guilt = about what you have done

Shame draws the question of what am I guilty off. Sometimes it is not something you have done or not done!

Guilt will give a reason for shame, if not in eyes of others, at least before God and self (unless it is surpressed)

- A mistake
- A deliberate choice
- A disability
- Lack or resources
- A misfortune
- A disaster
- attacked, pain, suffering...
- Association with others having shame






- What is shamed?

social structure based on honor/shame

Patron – Client relationship: a mutual arrangement between a person that has authority, social status, wealth, or some other personal resource (patron) and another who benefits from their support or influence (client). (Wikipedia).

setting up something new!

Context: in an honor-shame host culture

TRADITIONAL STRUCTURE = ESTABLISHED HONOR RANKINGS (elders, status, ...)

NEW STRUCTURE
= NEW HONOR RANKINGS!
(e.g. a hospital or university or church)

- Outsiders with no or different status.
- Insiders with new achieved status and skills.
- New honor competition!
- Seek honor (respect) for local culture

setting up something new!

- Explain the new relationships. (Model servant leadership)
- Know and involve the honor-shame circle of people involved

- You are not hiring just individuals for a job, but their honor-shame circle influence as well (family, friends, ...). The repercussions of that will show up differently if you are host or guest in the culture.

- <u>Decide where explicit ministry happens</u> (counting the cost of opposition for one, a few, or many). Factors include the size of group where conversations happen.


What are our motives giving help?

Five Pillars of Islam

Practice depends more on conforming to rules than to principles from the heart = achieved honor





relevant Worldview Differences

ISLAM	CHRISTIANITY
	man: made in the image of God + sin (depravity): needs an external savior
know and who can do anything he	Trinity, relational, loving (already before creating anything). Intimately involved in our lives.
God's rule thru Sharia (external)	God's rule from within (Holy Spirit), overflowing outwardly
	unity in diversity, many cultures, individuality also acknowledged, the church







- "If God wills" ('the Lord willing')
- Practically "Whatever happens is God's will"

Allah's moral character is ultimately unknowable, and Allah's ways are beyond all understanding. Muslims are not certain about God's ultimate attitude or will towards them (incl. forgiveness)

Allah's names are the most merciful ٱلْرَحْمَـانُ and most loving
 but for practical reasons he is primarily judge and ruler.

• Allah is not known in the day to day affairs of the life of a Muslim (searching for that power/love)

Perhaps nothing more separates Christianity from Islam more than the attitude toward **Suffering**

For the Muslim, suffering is not part of God's will, but a part of weakness.

Islam denies the cross, not from historical certainty, but out of theological necessity.







Theological opposites as illustrated by their origins:

Islam begins when the prophet Mohammed flees Mecca from suffering and persecution (= shame) and goes to Medina (the *Hijra*). There he builds up political and military power as tools for his purposes and own freedom (honor).

Christianity begins with Christ, God incarnate, refusing the way of military and political power, and choosing suffering and persecution in order to set a sin and shame-suffering humanity free.

Honor & Shame

Power, wealth, success and even knowledge are signs of God's blessing or of being on "God's side"

There is no right to change your religion (out of Islam) "A Muslim who renounces Islam has, in Allah's judgment, forfeited his right to live; he has committed ... high treason" (Imam Muhammad Al-Asi, Imam of the Islamic Center, Washington, D.C., 2005)

From a Muslim Point of View: 'Historic' Honor-Shame issues

"Christians have sinned against Muslims" {crusades, colonial period, Israel, ...}

Christians don't have God's latest revelation, Christianity is only second best...

➔ Just being attached to something associated with Christianity can bring a sense of shame.



• You can honor a king by just obeying his rules, but a king is even more honored (or glorified) when his subjects <u>love</u> him. The invitation is to give God the greatest honor in a relationship! Freely loving is greatest!







- God is the greatest (Allahu Akbar) in all things, i.e. He has the highest honor in all things, including love.
- Love is greatest when someone gives His life for others.
- God has demonstrated, and has given us, this greatest and most honored love in Christ, His death and resurrection.

the missing middle in honor shame cultures



Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever. (Westminster Shorter Catechism)

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God - (Romans 3:23)


<u>Our sin:</u>

- Offends, dishonors God. His creation tainted, a shamed race.
- Is <u>our</u> shame before God, ourselves, and others.

The solution:

- The Cross, Love, Grace; Jn 3:16, Ro 5:8

The cross takes any boasting away. In Christ we are all equal, receiving His honor → New Community

4 Whose Honor Do We Seek In Compassion?

We are not seeking merit or honor for ourselves!? Or are we? We are God's channels to restore His honor, based on His already finished work.

Love God, Love Neighbor = how we serve; = summary of the OT Law. Can be done in own strength (weakness of the law), or out of abiding in Christ (=loving God, bearing fruit – See Jn 15).

Kinds of "Christian" ministry:

- 1) Demonstrating what Christians and our values are? (How great these are, how good we feel, defending those seeking our own honor?)
- 2) Fruit-bearing and a passion to seek God's glory. Showing God and inviting under his Lordship? "Man shall not live from bread alone" (nor healthcare, justice, ...) he would still fall short of the glory of God.

Let us not confuse the effect and expressions with the source itself Missions is *living from* and *inviting to* the Source and is *expressed* and *demonstrated* in Compassion



Some Checkpoints:

- Do I serve *from grace* or *for honor*? Is my compassion my doing or the fruit of abiding? Whose glory/honor am I after?
- Can I recognize, or will I trust, God's sovereignty into the situation to where He sends me to show compassion, and keep focused on the source, realizing His love and grace?
- Did Jesus have to die for this? Do I withhold parts of His love when I share?

The commitment to social change will inevitably at some point come into <u>conflict</u> with the desire to see men and women become disciples of Jesus. The only way forward in this dilemma is to <u>resist all pressure to</u> <u>compartmentalize</u> our lives and pursue our calling in a holistic way.


Seeking the honor of the community by outreach


- Permission and ownership from the local leaders

- Incarnational & contextual: honoring the culture


Discern Opposition

- Avoiding extraction (of families, individuals)


- 1. Greatest honor is received when being most loved.

- **3**. The gospel: Restores God's and our honor, a new community.
