Election Results: Abortion Major Factor *Voters also responsible for policies of their representatives*

Abortion was a major factor in last week's election in the United States. The overturning of *Roe* v. *Wade*, and personal support for abortion, motivated 57% of Democrats to get out and vote, impacting 65% in their candidate choices. In Pennsylvania, abortion motivated 21% of Republicans to switch and vote Democrat, giving victory to the Democrat. By contrast, the overturning of *Roe* and opposition to abortion motivated only 23% of Republicans to vote, and impacted 32% in their candidate choices (https://www.kff.org/other/poll-finding/2022-midterm-election-kff-ap-votecast-analysis/). Consequently, support for abortion and Democrat candidates was much stronger than anticipated; there was no Republican "red wave"; and the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives are still undecided.

<u>Voters are complicit</u>: We have a representative form of government whereby we are free to choose who will represent us. When we choose a representative, knowing what they stand for and how they are likely to vote, then we share responsibility for their decisions. When a person votes for someone who is pro-abortion, and that representative supports abortion, then the same voters are complicit in abortion. There is innocent blood on both the hands of the representative and the hands of those who voted for him.

<u>Declining Church, declining culture</u>: For decades, Barna Research has been tracking cultural trends in the United States, including Christianity and the Church. Most Christians do not have a Biblical worldview, and increasing numbers are embracing non-Christian, secular, postmodern, and Marxist beliefs that directly conflict with Biblical Truth. Yet they don't realize this problem. The biggest disparities are between "practicing Christians" who: (1) are under 45 versus 45 and older; and (2) live in cities versus those who live in suburbs or rural areas (https://www.barna.com/research/competing-worldviews-influence-todays-christians/).

Solutions:

- Read your Bible daily and search for True Truth regarding the sanctity of human life, abortion (child sacrifice), innocent bloodshed, purpose of law and government, etc.
- Parents, get your children out of public schools and teach them Biblical foundations.
- Pastors, priests, professors and teachers rebuild the foundations of a Biblical worldview, doing so consistently now and for generations to come.
- Get off most social media, be very careful who you listen to and where you get news.

Pray about and do all the above solutions where you have authority and responsibility.
