Words of the LORD for the USA

(Part 2)

When King Solomon and all the leaders and people of his nation dedicated "the house of the LORD" – the most magnificent temple ever built for the LORD – "he stood before the altar of the LORD" on a platform in the courtyard. Then he humbly and unashamedly "knelt on his knees in the presence of all the assembly of Israel and spread out his hands toward heaven" (2 Chronicles 6:12-13). Representing the people, he prayed:

"When they [the leaders or people] sin against You (for there is no man who does not sin) and You are angry with them and deliver them to . . . if they take thought . . . and repent and make supplication to You . . . saying, 'We have sinned, we have committed iniquity and have acted wickedly'; if they return to You with all their heart and with all their soul . . . and pray . . . then hear from heaven, from Your dwelling place, their prayer and supplications, and maintain their cause and forgive Your people who have sinned against You" (2 Chronicles 6:36-39).

During the founding of the United States, General George Washington and the Continental Congress (10 times), and later Presidents Washington and Adams, issued proclamations calling the people to voluntarily gather on a particular day to pray, fast, and humble themselves before the LORD. President Lincoln did the same three times during the Civil War. In response, the LORD gave us our freedom, enabled us to birth and establish the nation on good foundations, got us through the Civil War (which President Lincoln discerned was God's judgment for slavery), and then restored and blessed us like no other nation in history.

I believe God Almighty is calling us to truly humble ourselves before Him and return to Him with all our hearts and souls. He is calling us and the entire world to account for abortion. He is calling us to be honest with Him and confess our sins of idolatry, immorality, abortion, and so much more. In every town, city, county, state, and for the nation, we should schedule a day to humble ourselves together before the LORD, with prayers and fasting. We should confess to God exactly how "we have sinned . . . committed iniquity and have acted wickedly," including for the number of babies whose innocent blood was shed in our community and state, and the 63 million nationwide. If we do this, we can have confidence of His forgiveness, and hope for restoration. If we do not, we do not.

Please pray that every state in our nation (and your nation) will do this; and for each member of the U.S. Supreme Court, and that they will nullify *Roe* v. *Wade* this month.

Action: (1) Find out the number of abortions in your community and state. Your state right-to-life organization likely knows. The GLC will soon have graphs ready for each state. (2) Talk with the pastors, priests, and pro-life/family leaders and schedule a solemn day for prayer, fasting, humbling before the LORD, and confession of sin for your community or city.
